Midcareer academic environmental scientists from North America (Canada, Mexico, and the United States) are invited to apply for the 2013 Leopold Leadership Fellowships. The program provides researchers with the skills, approaches, and theoretical frameworks for translating their knowledge to action and for catalyzing change to address the world's most pressing sustainability challenges.

Up to 20 Fellows will be selected to participate in two intensive training sessions a year apart to build and enhance their skills for leading change wherever they choose to work on local to global scales. Applications are welcome from a broad range of disciplines including the biophysical and social sciences and technical, medical, and engineering fields related to the environment and sustainability. Applicants must be employed by an academic institution, be midcareer, have a faculty position, and be active in teaching and research.
